

# Bishop CISD Instructional Plan Summary 2020-2021

The instructional plan for the 2020-2021 academic school year was approved last night by Bishop CISD School Board members. At this time, they have voted to restrict face-to-face instruction providing only remote instruction for the first four weeks of the school calendar. We are tentatively scheduled to begin face-to-face instruction on September 21, 2020. Closer to that date, we'll determine if we need to extend remote instruction for an additional four weeks.

With the guidance provided to us by the Texas Education Agency, we've included the options that we can offer at this time. We will continue to monitor the health and safety of all students and will make decisions accordingly. The following highlights the main points of each of the plans as they may vary at the different campuses. Please know that these are simply highlights and should not be seen as a comprehensive list of guidelines/restrictions.

## **Bishop High School:**

### Option One – 100% remote instruction

- Students engage in no less than 240 minutes of synchronous and asynchronous instruction five days per week.
- All activities/assignments must be completed and submitted daily.
- Core classes are completed in their entirety in one semester.

### Option Two – 100% face-to-face

- Students attend onsite five days per week.
- Core classes are two periods long and are completed in their entirety in one semester.
- A few electives are double period but most are single period courses.
- Students will remain in the same classroom the vast majority of the day with instruction being delivered remotely.
- Student interaction is limited as they will remain in a small group the majority of the day.
- Students will eat lunch in the classroom.

## **Luehrs Junior High:**

### Option One – 100% remote instruction

- Students engage in no less than 240 minutes of synchronous and asynchronous instruction five days per week.
- All activities/assignments must be completed and submitted daily.

### Option Two – 100% face-to-face

- Students attend onsite five days per week.
- Students will remain in the same classroom the vast majority of the day with instruction being delivered remotely.
- Student interaction is limited as they will remain in a small group the majority of the day.
- Designated entrances/exits for each grade level
- Students will eat lunch in the classroom.

**Bishop Elementary:**

## Option One – 100% remote instruction

- Students engage in no less than 180 minutes of synchronous and asynchronous instruction five days per week.
- All activities/assignments must be completed and submitted daily.

## Option Two – 100% face-to-face

- Students attend onsite five days per week.
- Students will remain in the same classroom the vast majority of the day with instruction being delivered by the teacher who will come to the students.
- Student interaction is limited as they will remain in a small group the majority of the day.
- Designated entrances/exits for each grade level
- Students will eat lunch in the classroom.

**Bishop Primary:**

## Option One – 100% remote instruction

- Students engage in no less than 180 minutes of synchronous and asynchronous instruction five days per week.
- All activities/assignments must be completed and submitted daily.

## Option Two – 100% face-to-face

- Students attend onsite five days per week.
- Students will remain in the same classroom the vast majority of the day with instruction being delivered by the teacher who will come to the students.
- Student interaction is limited as they will remain in a small group the majority of the day.
- Students will eat lunch in the classroom.

**Petronila Elementary:**

## Option One – 100% remote instruction

- Students engage in no less than 180 minutes of synchronous and asynchronous instruction five days per week.
- All activities/assignments must be completed and submitted daily.

## Option Two – 100% face-to-face

- Students attend onsite five days per week.
- Students will remain in the same classroom the vast majority of the day.
- PK and Kinder students will be grouped and taught by the same teacher.
- First and Second grades will be grouped and taught by the same teacher.
- Student interaction is limited as they will remain in a small group the majority of the day.
- Students will eat lunch in the classroom.

**Additional points for all students:**

- Students will not receive deliveries during the school day including but not limited to meals, books, gym clothing, etc.
- Parents who choose face-to-face instruction will do so with the understanding that students will be mandated to wear a mask/face shield throughout the school day. All staff members will do the same.
- Parents choosing remote instruction will agree to terms of daily school requirements or children will be counted absent on that day.
- Parents choosing remote instruction will make every effort to provide a technology device for their child as well as reliable Internet connectivity.
